

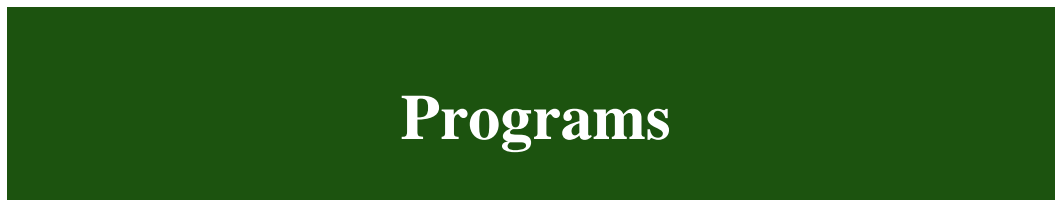
New Castle Conservation District
COVER CROP COST-SHARING
YOU MUST APPLY BEFORE PLANTING
SIGNUP STARTS AUGUST 11th

The New Castle Conservation District is offering cost-share assistance for cover crops to be planted this fall. Fields must be in New Castle County. There is a minimum of 5 acres and a maximum of 250 acres per applicant. Drilled or lightly incorporated rye, wheat, triticale, barley, oats, forage radishes, and crimson clover or hairy vetch with rye are approved. Aerial seeding is approved for rye, wheat, triticale, and crimson clover or hairy vetch with rye. Cost-share rate for unharvested cover crop is \$50 per acre. Cost-share for cover crop harvested for grain is \$30 per acre. Planting deadline is October 31st.

This year, homegrown seed must be tested. Cost-sharing provided.
